The research project CLICCS B2 Work Package 2 <u>Dynamics of Climate Governance: Norms, Contestation</u> <u>and Policies</u> is looking for a student assistant (35 hours/month) ideally starting on 1_{st} September 2022 for a period of nine months until May 2023. CLICCS B2 Work Package 2 is chaired by Antje Wiener, PhD FAcSS MAE, and focuses on climate justice and contestations of global climate governance norms with a specific focus on sensitive regions. The Cluster of Excellence Climate, Climatic Change and Society (CLICCS) at the Center for Earth System Research and Sustainability (CEN) is an interdisciplinary cluster of research addressing the overarching question: "Which climate futures are possible and which are plausible". You will have the opportunity to support the project with research and administrative tasks and be part of an interdisciplinary research environment.
